



Construction Begins in 2008 Open House Scheduled

Final design plans and construction schedule for Phase I of the Canal Importation Ponds & Outfall (CIPO) Drainage Improvement Project are nearing completion. City Council approved the project in October and construction will begin in early spring.

By late winter, you will see pre-construction activities in the area, including set-up of construction trailers, building of temporary access roads and bridges and installation of a pipe system to lower the groundwater prior to excavation. Excavation

and construction work is scheduled to begin on the west side of the Red Fox Natural Area in the spring.

Before excavation begins, Fort Collins Utilities will be hosting an open house with final Phase I design plans and a proposed construction schedule. Utilities and Natural Resources staff, in addition to engineering consultants, landscape designers and contractors, will be on hand to answer your questions and address your concerns.
